

Velma A. Hansohn, 72

Nov. 19, 1920 — Dec. 2, 1992

KIRON — Velma A. Hansohn was born Nov. 19, 1920, the daughter of Jacob and Bertha Schlie Kluver. She died Dec. 2, 1992 at the Crawford County Memorial Hospital in Denison, at age 72 years. She was born in Goodrich Twp., and raised on a farm near Ricketts and received her education in a rural school near her home. For a number of years, she worked as needed for neighboring farm homes.

June 22, 1942 she married Edwin Jacoby at the St. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Defiance. The couple settled on a farm near Defiance and were blessed with the birth of five children. In 1964, they moved to Denison where they subsequently purchased and operated a bar from 1968 to 1973. In 1970, Edwin died.

June 10, 1978, she married Edward Hansohn at the St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Denison. They made their home in Kiron where she lived at the time of her death.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her first husband, Edwin, and two children, Diane in 1948 and Dean in 1950; and one brother, Raymond. Survivors include two sons, Dennis Jacoby (Ilene) of Denison; and Duane Jacoby (Kathy) of Denison; one daughter, Pat Messenbrink (David) of Denison; and one step-son, Allen Hansohn (Sandy) of Kiron; 8 grandchildren; two step-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild; 1 brother, Albert Kluver (Dorothy) of Carroll; and 1 sister, Dorothy Stein (Archie) of Ida Grove.
