HARLAN - Lenore Haskell, 75, of Omaha, died Jan. 3, 1991, at Methodist Hospital in Omaha. Clifford Haskell, 76, of Omaha died Jan. 1, 1991, at Immanuel Methodist Center in Omaha. They were former Harlan residents. They moved to Skyline Manor in Omaha in 1985.

She was employed as a florist in a Harlan flower shop for many years. She was a member of the Northwest Hills United Church of Christ in Omaha, the Priscillas, the P.E.O., the Harlan Literary Club and the Harlan Golf and Country Club. He served with the Marines during WW II. He was the Harlan City Clerk until 1976 and was president of the Iowa Municipal Finance Officers Association in 1970.

Their survivors include three daughters, Mrs Homi (Karen) Mehta of Medina, OH.; Mrs Dan (Mary) Watters of Oklahoma City, OK., and Susan Haskell of Carroll; and six grandchildren. She is also survived by one sister, Mrs Bill (Maurine) Heilman Jr. of Indianola; and one brother, Gaige Walters of Sarasota, FL. He is survived by one brother, John Haskell of Omaha.
