EARLING — Pauline Lenora Heese, daughter of Albert and Mary Ellen (Kelleher) Walker was born June 26, 1905 at Portsmouth. As a child she moved with her family to Neola, where she attended St. Patrick's High School, graduating in 1923. She then moved to Omaha where she attended Van Sants Business School. She then became employed as a PBX operator.

Feb. 9, 1931, she married Marcus "Mac" Heese at St. John's Catholic Church in Omaha. Four children were born to this union. After their marriage, they moved to Earling, where he worked in the Heese Family Lumber Yard. After his death in Feb. of 1958. She continued to reside in Earling, and in May of 1988, became a resident of the Little Flower Haven in Earling. This has been her home since that time. She died May 4, 1993 at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 87 years, 10 months and eight days. She was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church and Catholic Daughters of American, St. Katherine's Court #266, both of Earling.
