

## Lucile Holloway, 83

**KIRKMAN** - Lucile Holloway, daughter of Leander and Martha Davenport was born on a farm in Ringold County, IA on May 7, 1905. She died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan on June 20, 1988 at age 83 years, one month and 13 days. She attended school in Ringold County and grew to adulthood on her parent's farm.

On Jan. 17, 1922, she married Scott Holloway in Clarinda. Eleven children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed in MO until 1934, when they moved to Shelby county. They farmed near Harlan until 1941, when they moved to a farm near Kirkman. After Scott retired from farming shortly after 1960, they continued to live on the farm in the summer and Glendale, AZ, in the winter months until 1980, when they moved to Irwin. After the death of Scott on Aug. 30, 1983, she continued to live in Irwin.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by four sons, Donald, James, Robert and Fred; two brothers, Loyd and Roy and three sisters, Marie, Doris and Florence.
