WALNUT - Wilma L. Hansen was born Nov. 1, 1929, in Audubon, the daughter of Oluf and Lucie Berg Winther, and was one of six children in the family. She attended school and graduated from Audubon High School. She then attended and graduated from Commercial Extension Business College in Omaha, NE.
