

Evelyn J. Havick, 89

June 28, 1910 - Jan. 12, 2000

OAKLAND - Evelyn Junette Havick, daughter of Lester and Delma (Jorgensen) Fick, was born June 28, 1910, at Culbertson, MT. While growing up, Evelyn's family moved to Washington, MN and finally settled on her grandfather's farm in Iowa.

April 12, 1936, she married Franklin Maynard Havick in Harlan. They became the parents of four children. They lived on a farm six miles northeast of Oakland and began farming with Franklin's brother, Elmer. Three years later, Elmer married and moved to Kirkman. Evelyn and Franklin continued to live on the farm purchasing their own farm one mile south in 1944. In 1955, they moved to this farm. In 1941, they joined the Oakland United Methodist Church where Evelyn taught Sunday School. She helped with 4-H for many years while her children were involved. She was a member of the "Our Friday Out" neighborhood club. After her children were grown, she was employed at the Oakland Manor for 13 years. She became a resident of the Oakland manor in January of 1996, where she made her home until her death. She died Jan. 12, 2000, at the Oakland Manor at age 89 years, six months and 14 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her sister, Fern Duke, and brother, Ernest Fick. Survivors include her husband, Franklin Havick of Oakland; Merry Beth (Gary) Nilan of Oakland; Susan (Mike) Hogzett of Harlan; Franklin Havick III (Nita) of Oakland; Paul Havick (Diane) of Winterset; eight grandchildren; two step-grandchildren and five great grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Jan. 15, 2000, at the Pauley Funeral Home with Rev. Paul Wilcox officiating. Burial was in the Harlan Cemetery with Evan Havick, Kerri Velazquez, Kelli Beckell, Melissa Nilan, Heidi Hoffmann and Robin Bennett honorary casket bearers.
