SPOKANE, WA – Jeanne Kimball Heidke was born April 18, 1924, in Irwin to Lee and Lillie Kimball where she grew up and attended area school. She had been employed as an x-ray technician at the Sacred Heart Medical Center Building and later at the Veterans Administration Medical Center retiring in 1988.
