

## David Henderson, 59

*Oct. 20, 1944 - July 20, 2004*

**BILOXI, MS** – David Joseph Henderson, the son of James D. and Helen B. Brown Henderson, was born Oct. 20, 1944, in Moline, IL. He was raised in Cedar Falls, and attended Cedar Falls High School. After high school, he joined the United States Navy and served on the USS Franklin D. Roosevelt SV 42 in the Bay of Pigs conflict during the Cuban Missile Crisis. After receiving an honorable discharge from the Navy, he moved to California where he worked for PSA Airlines and was a meat cutter. For the past 20 years he has been a resident of Biloxi, MS. David died July 20, 2004, at Santa Maria Retirement Center in Biloxi, MS, at age 59 years and nine months.



He was preceded in death by his parents and an aunt and uncle, Wilma and Wallace Henderson.
