D. Doyce Hildebrand, 77

HANCOCK – D. Doyce Hildebrand was born in James Township, Pottawattamie County. He graduated from the Hancock High School in 1940. He served his country in the U.S. Army during WW II. He was a farmer and was a member of the Iowa Cattlemen's Association. He died March 4, 2000, on his farm near Hancock from an apparent heart attack.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Lois Hildebrand of Hancock; two daughters, Karen Hildebrand of Denver, CO and Mary Hildebrand of Co. Bluffs; and two sons, Don (Jackie) Hildebrand of Oakland and Dean (ReAnn) Hildebrand of Oakland; four grandchildren; two brothers, Virgil (Elaine) Hildebrand of Hancock and Charles (Dorothy) Hildebrand of Denver, CO.

Funeral services were held March 7, 2000, at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca, with Mr. Wayne Paulsen officiating.
