

## David Holloway, 41

*April 8, 1962 - May 17, 2003*

**HARLAN** – David Frederick Holloway, the son of Fred and Donna Fiscus Holloway, was born April 8, 1962, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital. He was the oldest of four children in the family. He was baptized Dec. 12, 1976, at the Church of Christ in Harlan, by Evangelist John Kinyon. David attended kindergarten through 12th grade at Irwin Community School, graduating with the class of 1980. He worked for two years with Western Engineering doing road repair in Kansas and Oklahoma. Mother's Day, May 9, 1982, David suffered a head injury that required surgery to remove a blood clot from his brain, which left him paralyzed on his left side. After much physical therapy he was able to walk with a cane. In 1989, his father died of a heart attack. The family moved to Harlan in 1988 and David continued to live with his mother until he was hospitalized in Harlan, March 25, 2003. He was transferred to Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, NE, April 30, 2003. He had surgery for colon cancer May 5, 2003, but the cancer had already spread to his liver. He died May 17, 2003, at Clarkson Hospital at age 41 years, one month and nine days.



David was preceded in death by his father, Fred Holloway; his paternal grandparents, Scott and Lucile Holloway; and his maternal grandparents, Raymond and Lovie Fiscus. He is survived by his mother, Donna Holloway of Harlan; his brother, Steven Holloway (Linda) and their children, Blake and Becca of Coeur D-Alene, ID; brother, Kenneth Holloway (Denise) and their daughter, Emily of Harlan; and his sister, Lisa (Tom) Bergner of Fleming, CO; aunts, uncles and cousins.
