

## **Dorothy E. Holloway, 81**

**Nov. 19, 1916 - June 28, 1998** v

**ASPINWALL** - Dorothy Emeilien Utecht was born Nov. 19, 1916, on the family farm in Lincoln Township, rural Plymouth County to Carl H. and Sophia M. (Lau) Utecht. She received her education in a country school in Plymouth County.

She married Joseph J. Holloway July 1, 1939, in Sioux City. The couple had farmed in Plymouth County for several years and then moved to a farm near Atlantic. In 1968 the family moved to a farm near the Corning and Bedford areas. Mr. Holloway died Jan. 16, 1972. She continued to live in the Bedford area until 1990 when she moved to Aspinwall. She died June 28, 1998, at Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, at age 81.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband in 1972; three brothers, Oris, Walter and Carl Utecht; and two sisters, Loraine Cook and LaVon Laird. Survivors include two sons and daughters-in-law, John (Cindy) Holloway of Aspinwall and Ervin (Velvet) Holloway of Harlan; a sister, Helen Bahney of Onyx, CA; six grandchildren, Shawn, Pamela, Deborah, Tina, Crystal and Daniel; several nieces and nephews and great nieces and nephews.
