

Thomas Holloway, 80

May 8, 1925 - April 23, 2006

IRWIN — Thomas Darrell Holloway, the son of Uriah Scott and Lucile (Davenport) Holloway, was born May 8, 1925, at Eagleville, MO. He attended school at High Point Country School and in 1934 his family moved to rural Harlan, where he attended Douglas No. 9 Country School. Tom helped his father and brothers with farming and cattle.

Jan. 17, 1947, Tom married Helen Irene Gaer in Kirkman. To this union, five children were born, Daniel, Michael, Malinda, Cynthia and Thomas. After their marriage, the couple moved to a farm four miles north of Irwin. In 1969, they moved into Irwin to their current residence. Tom was employed at Farmland Foods, in Denison for 24 years. He also helped his daughter and son-in-law on their farm by Breda. He died April 23, 2006, at his home in Irwin at age 80 years, 11 months and 15 days.

In addition to his parents, Thomas was preceded in death by his brothers, James, Robert and Fred Holloway.
