

## Josephine A. Huebert, 94

*Feb. 13, 1906 - Sept. 19, 2000*

**PANAMA** – Josephine Antoinette Huebert was born Feb. 13, 1906, to Theresia (Vark) and John Windeshausen on a farm near Earling. She was baptized in Westphalia, and attended country school and grew to adulthood in the Earling area.

Sept. 10, 1924, she married Joseph Huebert at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling. Five children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed near Panama for several years before moving to Harlan. The couple later returned to Panama where they made their lifetime home. She worked as a midwife and housekeeper in the local area, and then worked as a nurse's aide at Myrtue Memorial Hospital for 20 years before retiring in 1972. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama, the Rosary and Altar Society, Sewing Circle and the American Legion Auxiliary. She has been a resident of Little Flower Haven Nursing Home since September 1988. She died Sept. 19, 2000, at Little Flower Haven Nursing Home at age 94 years, seven months and six days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Huebert, Aug. 31, 1979; a grandson, Thomas Huebert; a granddaughter, Mary Josephine Myers; one brother, Nicholas Windeshausen; sisters, Anna Gotta, Kate Schmitz, Clara Bruck, Mary Behrendt, Barb Funk, Lena Olson, Theresa Von Tersch and Lucille Stinn.
