

Hazel C. Hulsebus, 90

Nov. 23, 1906 - Oct. 13, 1997

HARLAN - Hazel Christina Hulsebus, daughter of Chris E. and Martha (Christiansen) Rold, was born Nov. 23, 1906, on a farm in the Cuppy's Grove area. She attended country school while growing to adulthood on her parents' farm.

Feb. 17, 1931, she married Raymond Hulsebus at the Altamont Baptist Church parsonage. They farmed near Corley for one year before moving to a farm at the west edge of Prairie Rose Lake. After the death of her husband, Raymond, Dec. 31, 1971, she left the farm and moved into Harlan, where she continued to reside until September of 1996. At this time she became a resident of Little Flower Haven. She was a member of Altamont Baptist Church. She died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital Oct. 13, 1997, at age 90 years, ten months and 20 days.

In addition to her parents and her husband, Raymond, she was preceded in death by her sister, Ivy May Henriksen in 1969. She is survived by her sister, Virginia Kade of Philadelphia, PA; one niece, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Oct. 16, 1997, at Altamont Baptist Church with Rev. David Erickson officiating. Burial was in Cuppy's Grove Cemetery in Shelby County with Max Klindt, Phil W.
