

## **Dennis Larsen, 48**

**SANTA DOMINGO**, – Dennis Larsen was born Nov. 1, 1941 in Brayton. His parents were Lewis and Anna Marie Larsen. He was one of four sons born to them. He was baptized in the Brayton Lutheran Church. When he was just a baby the family moved to Sac City, where he attended grade school and graduated from high school.
