HARLAN – Cecilia Mary Catherine Laube, daughter of John and Ellen (Myerscough) Ellner was born Nov. 23, 1908, at Prairie Du Rocher, IL. She died July 27, 1991, at Nebraska Methodist Hospital in Omaha, at age 82 years, eight months and four days. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church in IL., and attended school at the Mother House of the Precious Blood Sisters in Ruma, IL. After completion of the 8th grade, she attended Secretarial School.

Oct. 18, 1930, she married Henry Laube at St. Agnes Catholic Church in St. Louis, MO. They became the parents of four children. After their marriage, they made their home in St. Louis until 1948, when they moved to Harlan where Henry accepted the position of water plant superintendent. She later worked as an accountant for Coast to Coast Store, and as a clerk at Harlan Super Valu. They were privileged to have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary last Oct. In addition to being a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church, she was a member of St. Michael's Guild, and was a past chairman of the Mardi Gras committee. She was instrumental in helping to obtain a separate center for the Harlan Senior Citizens. She was a member of the Federated Women's Club of Harlan; Tuesday Afternoon Club; the Friday Club, and had been a Brownie and Girl Scout leader, and quilted lap robes for the residents of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan.

She was preceded in death by her parents and two brothers, Albert and John. Surviving her is her husband, Henry of Harlan; one son, John Henry Laube (Millie) of Houston, TX.; three daughters, Joan Marie (Richard R.) Rosman of Omaha, NE.; Lolita (Gerald) Gallagher of Glendale, CA., and Marian (John) Santi of Shelby Township, MI.; 12 grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren; and one great-great-granddaughter and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was concelebrated July 30, 1991 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan with Rev. Edward Kelly, the celebrant. Concelebrating was Rev. Vince Ohlinger assisted by Deacon Pat Davitt.
