



Sister Raymarie Lickteig, 63

Feb. 4, 1932 - Oct. 15, 1995

Westphalia - Bernice Antonia Lickteig, daughter of Ray and Mary (Schechinger) Lickteig, was born Feb. 4, 1932 at Westphalia. She died suddenly Oct. 15, 1995 at Bergan Mercy Hospital in Omaha at age 63 years 8 months and nine days. She was baptized and received her First Holy Communion and confirmed at the St. Boniface Church in Westphalia. She attended St. Boniface School, graduating with the class of 1951. She then entered the Order of the School Sisters of Saint Francis in Milwaukee, WI where she received her teaching degree. Sister Raymarie taught at Holy Angels School in Chicago, IL as well as St. Paul, IA, St. Pat's in Fremont, NE, Ryan High School in Omaha and St. Joseph's in Earling. She was a Research Librarian at Creighton University before doing nursing care at O.E.A. Manor in Omaha. Sister Raymarie resided at Our Lady of Lourdes Convent in Omaha and was employed at New Cassel Retirement Home.

She was preceded in death by her parents and step mother, Ada Lickteig. She is survived by her brothers and sisters, Cletus Lickteig (Virginia) of Denison; Therese M. Henscheid (Urban), Westphalia; Thelma Pauley (Erv), Defiance; Ed Lickteig (Cathy), Tulsa, OK and Ralph Lickteig (Nancy), Fremont, NE and many nieces, nephews and other relatives.
