## Angie Linde, 99

Angie, daughter of Henry and Janna Freese Auen, was born Nov. 27, 1887 in Carroll county. She was baptized in the Presbyterian faith. She was educated in rural schools near her home.

On Feb. 16, 1910 she married William F. Linde. They made their home on farms in the Arcadia area, moving to the Botna area in the early 1920's. Her husband died in 1926. She stayed on the farm near Botna until moving to Manning in 1958. She made her home with her daughter, Laura in Audubon for about three years before moving to the Friendship Home in Audubon in 1984. She died there on March 11, 1987 at age 99 years, 3 months and 12 days.

Besides her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents; by three brothers, Ben, Ralph and Eilert Auen; by three sisters, Jennie Johnson, Annie Auen and Tollie Tebben; by a son, Raymond; by a grandson, Arthur Linde; and by a son-in-law, Gerhard Schulz. She is survived by four children, Marvin Linde of Manilla; Laura Schulz of Audubon; Elmer Linde of Harlan and Arthur Linde of Harlan; by eight grandchildren; by 15 great-grandchildren; by two step-great-grandchildren; by two sisters, Nellie Grimsman of Carroll and Harmena Luchtel of Breda and by nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were March 14, 1987 at Ohde Funeral Home in Manning with Pastor Andrew J. Hofer of First Presbyterian church, Audubon, officiating. Burial was in Arcadia cemetery, with Chris Kirtley, John Linde, Robert Linde, Brownnie Polley, Roger Schulz, William Linde, James Linde, and Nick Hansen serving as casketbearers.
