

Marvin Carson Linde, 78

MANNING — Marvin, son of William and Angie Auen Linde, was born June 29, 1912 in Carroll county. He attended rural schools near his home. After his father's death, he worked for his mother on the farm in Shelby County, near Botna. After that he worked for a neighbor, Loni Scott.

Aug. 19, 1942, he married Gladys Davis at Omaha, NE. They had their home on a farm for several years and then moved to Aspinwall where he worked at the garage for five years and later worked for Harry Backhaus for a year. In 1952, they moved to the family farm, making their home there until 1985 when they retired and moved to Manning. He died June 11, 1991 at Manning General Hospital at age 78 years, 11 months and 13 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, March 27, 1991; a son, Arthur, as a teenager; his son-in-law, LeRoy Kirtley; and two brothers, Elmer and Raymond Linde. Survivors include his daughter, Linda Kirtley of Earling; a grandson, Christopher Kirtley; a sister, Laura Schulz of Audubon; a brother, Arthur Linde (Docia) of Harlan; a sister-in-law, Catherine Hansen of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
