

Arthur Fay Lamberson, 87

Feb. 9, 1917 - June 22, 2004

HARLAN – Arthur Fay Lamberson was born Feb. 9, 1917, in Fullerton, NE, to Clifford and Justa Forbes Lamberson. He graduated from Fullerton High School in 1934. He served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II.

He married his wife, Lois, of 60 years and they farmed in the Omaha, Council Bluffs, Audubon and Fiscus areas. He was a member of the Audubon Church of Christ. He died in Harlan June 22, 2004, at age 87.
