## **Carl Lamp, 89**

*June 15, 1910 – Feb. 26, 2000*

**AVOCA** – Carl Freddie Lamp was born June 15, 1910, at Avoca, son of Claus and Clara Hansen. Lamp was one of seven children in the family. He completed the eighth grade in school. He farmed until 1948, in the Avoca and Harlan areas. He worked for a number of years at Mercy Hospital in Co. Bluffs, and then became a self-employed carpenter, retiring in 1983. He was raised in the Lutheran Church. He died at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, Feb. 26, 2000, at age 89 years, eight months and 11 days.

Carl was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Herman, Arthur and an infant brother; and three sisters, Emma, Carrie and Laura. He is survived by his nephew, Larry Lamp (Jane); and a niece, Norma Jean Juhl; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Feb. 29, 2000, at the Knutson Funeral Chapel, Avoca, with Rev. Will Bynagte officiating. Burial was in the Graceland Cemetery. Casket bearers were Larry Lamp, Jack Mahaffey, Dennis Powers and Gail Powers.
