

Harriet Larsen, 77 ✓

May 11, 1921 - Jan. 22, 1999

MEDFORD, OR - Harriet Marie Larsen was born in Avoca, May 11, 1921, the daughter of Bert and Alma Pattee Sarvis. She attended country school until the fourth grade then went to Avoca Elementary and High School, graduating with the Class of 1938. She moved to California and attended college in San Mateo from 1938 until 1940. She worked in San Francisco until 1945 when she returned to Avoca.

She married Kenneth Larsen Oct. 13, 1945, in Omaha, NE. They returned to California in 1946 and lived there until 1963. They then moved to Medford, OR, where Harriet worked at the Rogue Valley Medical Center until 1975, when she and Ken returned to California. In 1981, they moved back to Oregon. In 1992, they moved back to Avoca. Kenneth died March 25, 1998. She died at the Rogue Valley Medical Center in Medford, OR, Jan. 22, 1999, at age 77 years, eight months and 11 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Kenneth; and a brother, Delbert Sarvis. She is survived by her children, Linda (Boyd) Travis and Harriet (Bob) Wager, all living in Medford, OR, and Charlotte (George) Stout of Modesto, CA; seven grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Memorial services were held Feb. 6, 1999, at the Knutson Funeral Chapel, Avoca, with Mr. Wayne Paulsen officiating. Inurnment was in the Graceland Cemetery.
