TENNANT – Esther Maguerite Linden, daughter of Oscar and Edith (McKeigan) Linden, was born Dec. 20, 1915, in Chalkbutte, SD. She was baptized at Calvary Baptist Church in Walnut. She graduated from Tennant High School in 1933, and then went on to Clarkson School of Nursing in Omaha, NE. In 1956, she worked at St. Joseph Hospital with an anesthetist degree. She worked for over 30 years at Myrtue Memorial Hospital as an anesthetist, until her retirement. She made her home in Tennant, until moving to Salem Lutheran Homes in Elk Horn.
