HARLAN – Joyce Louise Lund, daughter of Wilbert and Angela (Heitman) Roenfeld, was born Sept. 21, 1953, Council Bluffs. She was baptized at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Council Bluffs, and confirmed at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Jacksonville. She attended school at Elk Horn-Kimballton Schools graduating with the Class of 1972. After high school, she attended the Commercial Extension School in Omaha, NE, and graduated in 1974. After her graduation, Joyce worked in the Treasurer's Office at the Shelby County Court-house in Harlan, until May of 1975.



June 14, 1975, she married Darvin Lund at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Jacksonville. Three daughters, Kristina, Michelle and Amy, were born to this union. While her daughters were young, she stayed at home to take care of her children. As the girls grew older, she began working at the "Little Tiger" children's store in Harlan until it closed. In 1991, she started working at the KNOD radio station in Harlan. She was active in Luther League as well as serving as a 4-H leader for several years. After joining the United Methodist Church in 1975, she spent several years teaching Bible School and Sunday School. She died Aug. 30, 2001, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 47 years, 11 months and nine days.
