

Harvey A. Meink, 89

SPEARFISH, SOUTH DAKOTA – Services for Harvey Austin Meink, 89, Spearfish, were Oct. 16, 1989 at Fidler Funeral Chapel in Spearfish with the Rev. Gordon Higgins, officiating.

He died Oct. 11, 1989 at a Spearfish Hospital. Burial, with military honors, was at the Black Hills National Cemetery near Sturgis.

He was born Aug. 27, 1900 at Tennant to Wilhelm and Alice (Green) Meink. The family moved to Lane in 1916. In 1924, he moved to Harrold where he worked for the L.T. Straw International dealership. At night, he operated the light and power plant at Harrold. In 1926, he became area manager for International Harvester Co. In 1927, he moved to Rapid City. In 1928 and 1929 he lived in Strugis. In 1930, he moved to Spearfish.

In 1942, he entered the Army. After being discharged, he returned to Spearfish. In 1945 he moved to the present Meink farm west of Spearfish, where he farmed with his brothers.

Survivors include six sisters, Xilpha Long, Nancy Houlihan, Ruth Frost and Wilma Copas, all of Spearfish; Edith Ammon of Woonsocket and Addie Britton of Grand Island, NE.; and two brothers, Basil and Ralph Meink of Spearfish. He was preceded in death by a sister, Elfie Ring; and two brothers, Clifford Meink and Raymond Meink.
