

## Frances Dale Michael, 78

April 29, 1917-April 29, 1995

**Logan-** Frances Dale Michael was born April 29, 1917 to Carl August Michael and Gertrude (Freymuller) Michael on a farm three miles north of Magnolia. He was baptized at the Zion Lutheran Church in Magnolia where he was also a life long member. He lived on the farm until 1970 when he moved to Magnolia. He spent most of his life farming, worked at Schemmer Rock quarry and then as a custodian at the Magnolia School until his retirement. In 1982 he moved to Logan. He died April 29, 1995 at Immanuel Hospital in Omaha.

March 1, 1942 he married Shirley Young. To this union five children were born.
