

## Leland (Mike) Mikkelsen, 59

FORT COLLINS, CO. — Services for former Harlan businessman Leland (Mike) Mikkelsen were pending Thursday (Jan. 28) at a Fort Collins funeral home.

Mikkelsen, 59, of Fort Collins, died Wednesday night, Jan. 27, 1988, at Poudre Valley Hospital in Fort Collins.

Mikkelsen and his wife, Dorothy, moved from Harlan to Fort Collins in the early 1970s. He had operated the Co-op service station on South Twelfth St., in Harlan.
