

Roberta A. Morris, 32

DENVER, CO - Roberta A. Morris, born Sept. 19, 1955 at Crete, NE, daughter of Robert and Anna Morris died June 28, 1988 in Swedish Medical Center, Denver, CO at the age of 32 years of head injuries received Monday eve, June 27, when the vehicle she was driving collided with a recreational vehicle that ran a red light.

She was a 1973 graduate of Crawford, NE High School, she received her undergraduate degree from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln in 1977. She later obtained her law degree (1982) and doctorate (1987) from the University of Nebraska prior to moving to Denver in Dec. 1984, she had been an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of Nebraska.

She married Tom Falacienski of Denver on Feb. 7, 1986 in Hawaii. They made their home in Denver, CO, where both were employed as attorneys. She had numerous articles published in professional journals and presented many papers at psychological seminars nationwide. A contract had recently been signed to publish her doctoral dissertation as a textbook. She was a member of the American Psychological Association, Colorado Bar Association and the American Bar Association, where she also was a chairperson of a sub-committee of the law and technology section.

She is survived by her husband, Tom Falacienski, Denver, CO; parents, Robert and Anna Morris, Harlan; brothers, Richard, Arlington Heights, IL; Tom, Beatrice, NE and John, Omaha, NE. Private burial was held July 1, 1988 at Fairmount cemetery, Denver, CO.
