

## **Keith McClure, 70**

**Feb. 19, 1925 - Nov. 23, 1995**

**Harlan** - Dale Keith McClure, son of Dale H. and Faye Alexander McClure, was born Feb. 19, 1925 at Malvern. He attended East Liberty Country School in Mills County, graduated from Malvern High School in 1942 and grew to adulthood on the family farm near Malvern. He entered the United States Army, serving his country during World War II.

Jan. 24, 1945 he married Eleanor Jones at Glenwood. They became the parents of one son, Gary. He then farmed for a short time before becoming employed with General Woodworks in Co. Bluffs where he worked for thirty-one years. He then became employed by the Co. Bluffs School system where he was employed as a carpenter. He retired in 1985, and in 1990 they moved to Harlan to make their home. It was there that he died Nov. 23, 1995 at age 70 years, nine months and four days. While residing in Co. Bluffs he was a member of the First Christian Church. He was presently a member of Christ's Church in Harlan. They had the privilege of celebrating their 50th wedding anniversary in Jan. of this year.

He was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife, Eleanor of Harlan; his son, Gary (Pat) McClure of Harlan and two grandchildren. He is also survived by a sister and brother, Dorothy (Floyd) Thompson and Dwight (Gloria) McClure all of Co. Bluffs and other relatives.
