RED BANK, NJ – Margaret Kilcoin McCuen, daughter of Thomas and Margaret McCall Kilcoin was born Feb. 19, 1909 at Harlan. She was raised and graduated from the Harlan High School in 1926. She attended the University of Iowa and graduated from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. She married Roy McCuen in 1934 and to this union one son was born. She was a secretary for Dan Buckley before going to Omaha where she worked 22 years at Offutt Air Force Base. In 1964, she moved to New Jersey where she worked as a house mother at Rutgers University and then a clerk with the Monmouth County Jury until her retirement in 1974.

She died Nov. 7, 1988 at the Riverview Medical Center in Red Bank, NJ at age 79 years, 8 months and 18 days.
