

Kenneth J. Maiwald, 58

Nov 13, 1942 - Jan 6, 2001

AMARILLO, TX – Kenneth Joseph Maiwald was born Nov 13, 1942, to Verena (Schwery) and Joseph Maiwald in Harlan. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic Church in Panama. Following graduation from St. Mary's Catholic High School in Panama, in 1961, he enlisted in the U.S. Army where he was stationed at Ft. Carson, CO. As a result of an injury incurred while in training, Kenneth was honorably discharged. Returning to Iowa, he attended Barber College in Sioux City.

In August of 1965, he married Marci Waldron at Rapid City, SD. To this union, two sons were born. He was a barber in Denison, where he owned and operated his own shop until he became disabled in 1980. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, Junior Chambers of Commerce and worked for the U.S. Department of Labor. He died Jan 6, 2001, at Veteran's Affairs Nursing Home in Amarillo, TX at age fifty-eight years, one month and twenty-four days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Kenneth is survived by his sons, Thomas Maiwald (Amy) of Decatur, GA and Robert Maiwald of Marion; two grandchildren, Abby and Nate Maiwald; sisters, Marlene (John) Casasanta of Amarillo, TX, Althea (Joel) Kenkel of Horseshoe Bay, TX, and Lois (William) Kluck of Granite Shoals, TX; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
