

Tony Marchellino, 43

Dec. 21, 1960 - Aug. 16, 2004

KIMBALLTON — Tony Lange Marchellino was born Dec. 21, 1960, in Waverly. He lived in several towns around Iowa, including Colo, Ft. Dodge, Mason City and most recently with his mother in Kimballton. Marchellino was a 20-year member of the Sons of Silence Motorcycle Club including past-president of the Ft. Dodge chapter. He died Aug. 16, 2004, at his brother's home in rural Carroll due to complications of lupus at age 43 years.

Tony was preceded in death by his father, Francis J. Marchellino in August 1977. He is survived by his son, Josh Burns of Boone; his mother, Dorothy (Lange Marchellino) Hansen of Kimballton; his brother, J.M.
