RED OAK — Maxine Emma Louise Maxwell, daughter of Max and Hedwig (Huelle) Leu, was born Nov. 11, 1914, in Hastings. She grew up on the family farm near Hastings. She graduated from Henderson High School in 1933.

Maxine married Everett Maxwell April 27, 1935, at Afton. They farmed for several years at Silver City, Emerson and around Red Oak. Maxine and Everett purchased the Harlan Bowl and managed it from 1967 to 1977, when they retired and moved to Arizona. In 1989, Maxine and Everett moved to Red Oak. Maxine was a member of the Stratton Methodist Church. She died March 6, 2005, at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Council Bluffs, at age 90 years, three months and 23 days.
