COUNCIL BLUFFS – Kevin Patrick Meaney was born at Long Island, NY. He attended Tarkio College in Missouri where he received a degree in business. He served four years in the Army including a tour of Vietnam. He received the rank of Staff Sergeant. He also served in the Iowa National Guard for 26 years.
