

## Frances Miller, 81

*Dec. 17, 1922 - June 27, 2004*

**ATLANTIC** – Frances Maxine Madden Miller, daughter of Frank and Ella Gayle (Culver) Madden, was born Dec. 17, 1922, at Griswold. She attended rural country school at Griswold and Walnut.

June 2, 1966, Frances married Edward J. Miller at Elk Point, SD. After their marriage, they resided in Council Bluffs. Frances worked at Mercy Hospital in the Children's Ward and as a housekeeper for Bethany Lutheran Nursing Home in Council Bluffs for many years. She became a resident of the Atlantic Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in 1998. June 27, 2004 Frances died at Cass County Hospital in Atlantic, at age 81 years, six months and 10 days.
