

James Moody IV, 22

Aug. 18, 1980 - June 9, 2003

WASHINGTON, D.C. – James Irl (Jamey) Moody IV was born Aug. 18, 1980, in Graham, TX, to Lyn and James I. (Petey) Moody III. Jamey attended schools in Graham, TX, Roswell, NM and Harlan. He returned to Texas as a sophomore, and graduated from Graham High School in 1998. He attended Weatherford College in Weatherford, TX, graduating in 2001. Jamey was the first freshman of Harlan High School to letter in Show Choir. He lived in Washington, D.C. for the past two years and was employed by Hechts Dept. Store (division of May Co.) where he was a makeup artist, with plans of joining their International Makeup Artist Company in the near future. He died as a result of an accident June 9, 2003, in Washington, D.C. at age 22 years, eight months and 11 days.



He is preceded in death by his two grandfathers, John Curtis McGuire, Sr. and James I. Moody, Jr. He is survived by his parents Lyn and Alan Kelly of Harlan and James I.
