

Denny Myers, 63

March 28, 1943 - March 14, 2007

GIG HARBOR, WA – Denny Myers was born March 28, 1943, in Shelby to Dale and Delores Myers. He attended school in Shelby and graduated from Shelby High School in 1961. He served his country for four years as an Air Force Load Master, spending most of his time in and around Viet Nam. He then served his community for 30 years as a Pierce County Deputy Sheriff working as a patrol officer, a juvenile officer, co-coordinator of Crime Stoppers, liaison to the P. C. Sheriffs Posse, and finally as a community resource officer in the University Place School. He was recently named one of the two first recipients of the Sheriff's Department "Meritorious Service Award." He died March 14, 2007, at his home in Gig Harbor, WA, at age 63.



Denny was preceded in death by his parents.
