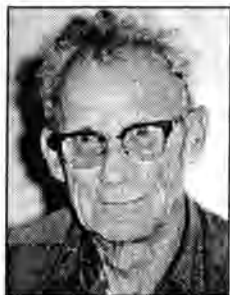

Ernest McConnell, 88

March 6, 1911 - Feb. 15, 2000

HARLAN – Ernest C. McConnell was born March 6, 1911, to Emily J. (Longcor) and Clark P. McConnell in Harlan. He was baptized at the Latter Day Saint's Church in Logan Feb. 20, 1983, and was an Elder in good standing until his death. He attended school in Harlan. May 5, 1942, he was inducted into the Army and served in the European Theater seeing action in Northern France. Following his discharge in December 1945, he returned to Harlan. During his life, he was employed by Carpenter's Hatchery, Stowe Produce and most recently by the Rural Electric Cooperative in Harlan. He died Feb. 15, 2000, at age 88 years, 11 months and 10 days.



In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers, Gaylord and Lester; and sisters, Ellen, Beatrice and Cecile; and niece, Janette. He is survived by his brother, Gerald McConnell of Torrance, CA; nephews, Bernard Nollen (Darlene) of Harlan and Darrell McConnell of Illinois; nieces, Beatrice (LaVerne) Koppold of Harlan; Genevieve Brown of Altoona; Sharon Crouse of Carroll and Janet (Mark) Lessert of Bloomdale, IL; and other relatives.

Funeral services with military rites were held Feb. 19, 2000, at Pauley Funeral Home with Elder Kenneth Moore and Elder Ron Dolan officiating. Honorary casket bearers were Ole D. Olson and Roy Fries.
