HARLAN — David Arnold Nash, son of Lionel and Margaret (Adams) Nash was born Dec. 16, 1947, at Gonzalez, TX. He died at the Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, NE., March 28, 1992, at age 44 years, three months and 12 days.
