Feb. 3, 1895 — Jan. 25, 1991

ELK HORN — Esther Pauline Nelson, daughter of John and Dorethea Jensen Lindstrom was born Feb. 3, 1895, near Audubon. She attended rural school in Audubon Co.

Feb. 16, 1916, she married James Nelson at Poplar. They farmed in Jackson twp. until 1946, when they moved to Kimballton. In 1972, they sold

their home in Kimballton and moved to Harlan. She had been a member of the Kimballton Immanuel Lutheran Church, and a resident of the Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn since 1977. She died there Jan. 25, 1991, at age 95 years, 11 months and 22 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, James in 1978; one brother, Tony Lindstrom and a sister, Margaret Petersen. Survivors include two half brothers, John Vithen of Harlan and Emil Vithen of Kimballton; two half sisters, Sadie Hansen and Oda Martens, both of Harlan; many nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Jan. 28, 1991, at the Kimballton Immanuel Lutheran Church with Pastor Steven Gronseth and Rev. LeVern Nielsen, officiating.
