HARLAN — Vivian Norgard, daughter of Hal and Mary Larsen Martin was born June 15, 1924, in Lincoln twp., Shelby county. She died March 23, 1993 at the Rose Vista Nursing Home in Woodbine, at age 68 years, 9 months and 8 days. She was confirmed at the Danish Evangelical Lutheran Church in Kimballton, May 7, 1939, and attended grade school at Kimballton. She graduated from Harlan High School in 1944.

Aug. 6, 1971, she married Harvey Norgard in Harlan. They made their home in Harlan until the death of Mr Norgard Nov. 29, 1992. She then became a resident of the Rose Vista Nursing Home in Woodbine.
