Jan. 20, 1925 – May 5, 2000

LAS VEGAS, NV – Milton James Neve was born Jan. 20, 1925, in Avoca, son of Henry and Anna C. Hinickson Neve. He was one of 14 children in the family. He was baptized Dec. 27, 1931, at the German Evangelical Lutheran Church in Avoca. He attended Avoca Grade and High School where he played football and graduated in 1943.

He married Jackie Wiley March 9, 1946, in Chicago, IL. They were the parents of four children, Terry, Kenny, James and Ronald. He worked for C.W. Transport of Bridgeview, IL, for 20 years.

He married Audrey Carlstrom Nov. 28, 1970, in Naperville, IL. When he retired in 1982, they moved to Las Vegas, NV. Audrey died in February of 1983 in Las Vegas. Milton died in Las Vegas, May 5, 2000, at age 75 years, three months and 15 days.
