

## **Roy P. North, 76**

*Oct. 16, 1922 – July 29, 1999*

**HARLAN** – Roy Percy North, son of Wray and Della (Louks) North, was born Oct. 16, 1922, at Simcoe, Ontario, Canada. He was baptized at the Grant Memorial Baptist Church in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada and attended school at the Simcoe Central Public School in Simcoe, Ontario, Canada.
