Wallace E. Randall, 84

AVOCA - Wallace Edward Randall was born in Knox twp., Pottawattamie Co., Dec. 20, 1905. He was the son of James and Lulu Robinson Randall. He was one of ten children in the family. He attended school in Avoca and graduated with the class of 1924.

He married Wilhelmina Vogt March 2, 1930 at Avoca. They made their home in Avoca, except for the three years they lived in Griswold and the three years in Greenfield. He spent most of his working years employed by the Avoca Creamery as a cream hauler. They were the parents of two children, Sharon and Jan. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church. He died at the Co. Bluffs Care Center in Co. Bluffs, May 28, 1990, at age 84 years, five months and eight days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one granddaughter, Heather Derby; seven brothers and sisters Kathleen Gross, Helen Bresee, Laura Henderson, Thornton Randall, Edith Messerschmidt, Murray Randall and Richard Randall. Survivors include his wife, Wilhelmina; their children, Sharon (Bill) Derby of Co. Bluffs; Jan Randall of Glenwood; 7 grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; one brother, Bernard Randall of Omaha, NE.; one sister, Marian (Paul) Muhs of Neola; besides nieces, nephews and other relatives.
