

Arnold Randeris, 72

March 18, 1920 — June 28, 1992

AUDUBON — Arnold Randeris, son of Mads and Agnes Christiansen Randeris, was born March 18, 1920 in Audubon County, and died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, at age 72 years, 3 months and 10 days. He was baptized and confirmed at the Ebenezer Lutheran Church, west of Audubon, and attended rural schools in Audubon County.

Feb. 15, 1944, he married Grace A. Bartelson in Omaha, NE. They farmed near Fiscus for several years. In 1948 they purchased a farm near Redline. He operated the farm until they retired and moved into Audubon in 1979. Grace died Jan. 8, 1992. He maintained his home until he became a resident of the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, in May of 1992.

Preceding him in death in addition to his wife were his parents; grandsons, Andrew Randeris and Chris Randeris; a sister, Vita Randeris. Survivors include his children, Gary (Paula) Randeris of Redline; Dennis (Patricia) Randeris of Jacksonville; Jane (Dale) Patton of Waterloo, NE.; 8 grandchildren; 1 great grandson; a brother, Harold (Dorothy) Randeris of Audubon; a brother-in-law, Junior (Marion) Bartelson of Fiscus; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
