

Dagny Overgaard Muller Rasmussen, 91

Aug. 7, 1905 - Nov. 3, 1996

KIMBALLTON - Dagny M. Rasmussen was born Aug. 7, 1905 to Thorvald Georg and Mette Jensen Overgaard Muller on a farm near Ord, NE. She died Nov. 3, 1996, at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn where she had resided since May of 1993. In 1908 she moved with her family to Kimballton. She was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton where she was a life-long member. She attended Kimballton Public Schools. She received her high school diploma from Grand View College in Des Moines in 1925. She also became a Certified Gymnastics Instructor at that time. She attended Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls. She was employed as a domestic worker in Omaha and Des Moines. She worked at Landmand's National Bank in Kimballton and Continental National Bank in Chicago.

In 1930, she married Emanuel Rasmussen. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary in 1990, and lived in their family home together until 1991, when he died. She worked at Myrtue Memorial Hospital for 30 years doing what she loved the most, caring for others.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Emanuel; one brother, Ove Overgaard Muller, and one sister, Gudrun Overgaard Muller Jorgensen. She is survived by her children, Judith Ann Meehan (Bill) of Des Moines; Kent Muller Rasmussen (Lela Mae) of Grinnell; Ivan Muller Rasmussen of Laughlin, NV and Karl Emanuel Rasmussen of Sunnyside, WA; ten grandchildren; 14 great grandchildren; two brothers, Svend Overgaard Muller (Neva) of Dallas, TX and Kai Overgaard Muller (Jean) of Anaheim, CA; a sister, Eva Johanna Muller Machutas (Leo) of Arlington, TX and many other relatives.
