MANILLA — Daniel Lee, son of Lee and Helen Miller Rocksien was born Jan. 30, 1942 at Grand Rapids, MI. Manilla has been his home since he was two years old, the time of his father's death. He was educated in the Manilla schools and graduated with from Manilla High School in 1961. Since 1968 he operated Rocky's Lounge on Main Street in Manilla; he was active in community life. During the 1980's he married Linda Ahrendsen. He suffered a heart attack Oct. 26, he died Oct. 28, 1992 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Omaha, NE., at age 50 years, 8 months and 28 days.

Besides his father he was preceded in death by his grandparents and by two sisters, Gay Ellen and Rosemary Helen.
