HARLAN — Kathleen "Katy" Marie Rattenborg, daughter of Peter and Anna D. Larsen Rattenborg, was born May 2, 1921, at Kimballton. She attended school at Kimballton until the eleventh grade when she and her family moved to Harlan. Katy was a member of the graduating class of 1938 from Harlan Community High School. Upon graduation, she went to business school in Omaha, NE. After attending business school, she was employed at Norgaard Drug Store in Harlan. She was employed there for 45 years.
