GRASS VALLEY, CA — Edgar Jacob Reinig was born Dec. 7, 1916, near Panama, to Mathias Jacob and Mary (Nollen) Reinig.

Edgar was married Sept. 18, 1943, to Mary Cosgrove in San Francisco, CA. To this union three sons, John, Douglas, and Mark, and one daughter, Sharon, were born. He moved to California in 1936 and was employed by the Argo Pump Co. and later owned and operated the Automart in Hayward, CA. He lived in that area until building his home in Grass Valley, CA where he retired. He was past president of the Lions Club, with whom he was a member for many years. He died Nov. 17, 2006, at the Golden Empire Convalescent Hospital in Grass Valley, CA, at age 89.
