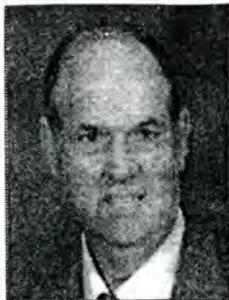


Ronald R. "Peanuts" Reinig, 65

Feb. 29, 1936 - Aug. 13, 2001

PORTSMOUTH – Ronald Richard "Peanuts" Reinig, son of Joseph and Martha (Leinen) Reinig, was born Feb. 29, 1936, in Portsmouth. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Portsmouth, and was a member of the graduating class of 1954 from St. Mary's Catholic School also in Portsmouth. He enlisted in the United States Army March 24, 1959. Upon return from duty overseas, he enlisted in the United States Army Reserve and was honorably discharged March 23, 1965. He operated the Rocket Tavern in Portsmouth, for many years, retiring in 1984. He was a lifetime member of St. Mary Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Portsmouth. He died Aug. 13, 2001, at the Immanuel Medical Center in Omaha, NE, at age 65 years, five months and 15 days.



In addition to his parents, Ronald was preceded in death by his brother, Gene, and sister, Joyce. He is survived by his sister, Marlene (Carroll) Reynolds of Omaha, NE; his nephews, Rick Prososki (Tammie) of Omaha, NE; Tim Prososki (Norene) of Pontiac, MD; Ron Prososki (Debbie) of Portsmouth; and other relatives.
